Flyers Sweep the Allen Park Bulldogs

Freshman Qualify for Playoffs

The Flyers Freshman improved their record to 5 - 2 and qualified for the Playoffs. The official playoff teams have not been announced but at 5-2 and only one game left in the regular season the Flyers Freshman are a lock. The First half of the game was a defensive struggle as both could only score a touchdown each. In the second half as both teams made adjustments, the scoring flood gates opened up. The teams were trading touchdowns until the Flyers got a break on a Bulldog fumble. The Flyers went up two scores and were able to hold the Bulldogs off as they walked away with a 34 - 25 victory.

Flyers JV Start Slow but Finish Strong.

In the JV game the Flyers struggled to get their offense running in its usual high gear. The Bulldogs played good defense in the first half as they held the Flyers to only six points until late in the second quarter. With about two minutes until the half the Flyers ripped off a long

touchdown run. The Flyers then kicked the extra point to take a 14 - 0 lead into the half. When the Flyers came out in the third quarter things were vastly different as the defense shut down the Bulldogs and the offense had no problems putting up two touchdowns in the third quarter. The Flyers cruised through the fourth quarter playing mostly reserves to a 28 - 0 victory. The JV record now stands 7 - 0.

Flyers Varsity Steal A Victory

The Flyers entered the day with a 2 - 4 record and faint hopes of qualifying for the playoffs. The Flyers knew they were playing for their playoff lives and they did not disappoint. The Flyers and the Bulldogs battled from the opening kickoff right down to the final sound of the horn. Both teams proved to have sturdy defenses and solid play on offense. With the score 15 - 8 in favor of the Bulldogs with about six minutes left in the fourth quarter the Flyers mounted a drive with the intent of taking the lead. With less than two minutes left the Flyers punched through the

Bulldog defense to score. The extra point try was no good. The score now at 15 - 14 the Flyers attempted an on-side kick and came up with the ball. With good clock management the Flyers were able to power their way down the field to get into the end-zone for the game winning score. That score came with just twenty one seconds left. The Varsity record is now 3 - 4 and their playoff hopes are still alive.
