Freshman Fall in the Final Seconds

The Flyers and the Washtenaw Blue Wolverines had met in the first game of the season with the Wolverines coming out on top 27-19. It was a hard fought battle that came down to the final quarter. The Flyers held a 7-0 lead and was poised to take a 14-0 lead into the half, but a block in the back canceled a touchdown just before the half. The Wolverines were able to put up six points midway through the third quarter. Neither team would score again until the Flyers fumbled the ball with twenty-four seconds left on the clock. The Wolverines picked up the loose ball and rushed off to a 12-7 lead. With just eighteen seconds left the Flyers ripped off a long run to get down to the Wolverine twenty yard line. Time ran out before the Flyers could get off another play. The Flyers end their season at 6-3.

In the JV Game Flyers took on the Lincoln Park Junior Rails. Earlier in the season
